## QUALITY CIRCLE OPERATION (QCO) ON BORDER SECTIONS

- Good structure / governance of QCO
- Works ongoing, pragmatic approach and good work to local solutions to treat local issues
- WG duplicated on other RFCs : Modane, Villa Opicina, RFC1
- Successful organisation to be deployed among other parts of the RFC 4 like FR-SP
- ⇒ an early involvment of the Corridor would have helped to prevent FR-SP cross-border issues

<u>Solution</u> => to work on a simultaneous translation pilot similar to the one developed in Forbach: steps to be taken, costs, requirements, the engagement from the parties involved, etc.



## BORDER SECTION FORBACH-SAARBRÜCKEN

- Language Forbach Saarbrücken
  - Derogation EPSF until Language Pilot successful completed
  - SNCF Réseau put project on hold?
- Extension SSC on border sections Forbach Saarbrücken
  - E.g. inclusion of German stretch of Forbach Saarbrücken line in EBA guideline



## **BORDER SECTION HENDAYE-IRUN**

- Language Hendaye Irun (and Cerbère Port Bou)
  - EPSF required French B1 for Spanish RUs reaching Hendaye
  - RENFE proposed 2<sup>nd</sup> French speaking person in the cabin as mitigation measure (expensive)
  - After that derogation until end of January 2022 introduced. Required at least until TT2023
  - AESF introduced same limitation on Spanish side
  - Communication protocol exists between IMs that permit them to speak in their own language (simplified speech?)

# => RUS NEED A CROSS BORDER EXEMPTION LIKE FOR FR-DE BORDER (for DB Cargo drivers)

ADIF requiring Spanish tax number to French RUs



## TEMPORARY CAPACITY RESTRICTIONS

• 15 weeks with >36h total closure on French side, total closure Pasaia – Irun (Spain) during one of the rare work free week-ends in France!

#### => NO COORDINATION OF WORKS

Works Bordeaux – Hendaye 2022-2023 no capacity (only 1 bandwidth per direction)

#### => NO TTR IMPLEMENTATION

#### **REQUESTS BY RUs:**

- Long term prevision of TCRs (10 years) necessary for RUs to define strategy
- Effect of recovery fund on TCRs?
  - French State Aid "surcoût travaux" to optimize planning of works?
  - Could also production costs by RUs for reroutings be covered by the recovery fund?



## **PCS TRAININGS**

- RFCs used to offer a PCS Trainings Offer on each Corridor
- RUs have no access to these trainings anymore

## COORDINATION OF RAG MEETINGS
